Maar de grote onderstroom van deze prachtige roman die als de meest diepzinnige van Austens oeuvre geldt bestaat uit het fascinerende tijdsbeeld dat zij tekent: Engeland in de jaren 1811-1813, toen het leven van de "landed gentry" nog in scherper contrast stond tot de elegante maar oppervlakkige "London style" waarvan Beau Brummel een exponent was. Een korte periode waarin waarden tegen elkaar worden afgemeten, aan de vooravond van Waterloo
